WHY DAY BOARDING

The Shivalik International School is the pioneer in the concept of day-boarding, hitherto an unknown concept to most of the region's residents. However today it has become the first choice of enlightened parents.

Day Boarding concept of schooling brings in advantages of both day-school and boarding school to ensure complete development of a child. This system of schooling is increasingly becoming popular among the parents for its many advantages over other systems.

■ A boon for all Parents

Parents might not have enough time on their hands to take care all the academic and extra-curricular needs of their wards. When a child spends entire day at a day-boarding facility, he gets extra help in academics whenever he or she may require , gets to learn various social skill as he is a part of a community for most of his/her waking hours. And many more aspects of the child's personality are groomed in the safe, secure and vibrant environment of the school.

■ Fewer Distractions

Day Boarding school does not give opportunity to the child to involve themselves in any harmful activities or habits as they work on strict timetables and most of the day-time is spent in school. They do not get to indulge in one of the major concerns of any parent -the television and the internet.

More time and better training for co-scholastic activities at school ensures perfect grooming of child's talent in many areas.

■ Nutritional Essentialities Fortified

Facility for fresh, nutritional and healthy food at a day-boarding school ensures that the proper diet of the child is taken care of. Eating at school mess also helps the child develop good social eating habits and table etiquettes.

House System

The house system infuses the students with the spirit of camaraderie, competitiveness and cohesion.

Assemblies

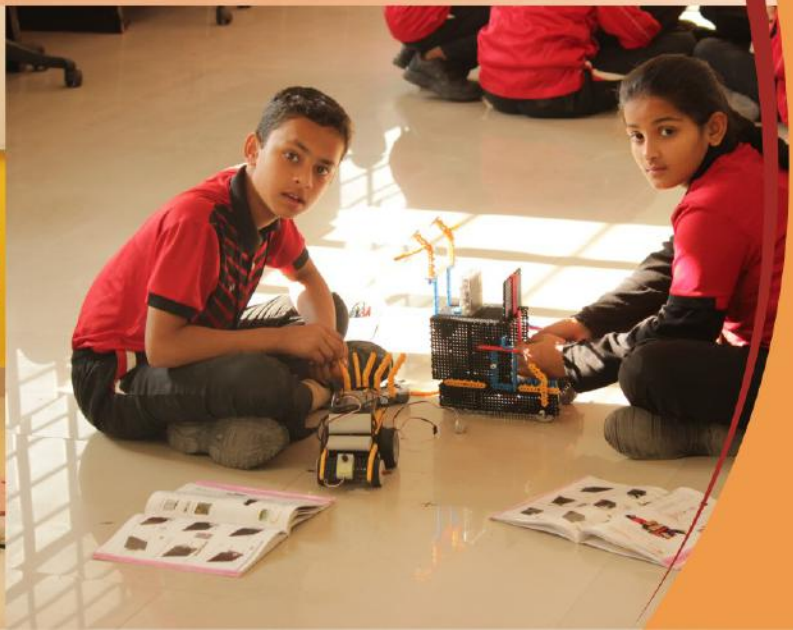

Life-Skill Training

Life skills are essentially those abilities that help promote mental well-being and competence in young people as they come face to face with the realities of life. It empowers young people with vital psycho -social skills such as handling peer pressure ,managing relations , managing emotions , anger management , managing stress , conflict resolution , effective communication managing emotions , good touch bad touch etc. In partnership with a global company, the school provides life-skill training and counseling on a fortnightly basis where experts impart program tailored to each age-groups needs.

Robotics

Robotics is an interdisciplinary subject, rather than learning subjects in isolation Robotics combines mechanical, electronic, electrical and programming skills. Students are motivated to learn by creating their own robotic devices, while at the same time gain a deeper understanding of interdisciplinary fields such as Physics and Mathematics.





Library

The library has a huge collection of books of almost all genres of literature and text books and reference books of different subjects. It is instrumental in inculcating reading habit among the students. The students make optimum use of the library for study and reference work. They are guided by well qualified librarian who help them in selecting the relevant study material.

The Abdul Kalam Hall (Auditorium)

This superb facility spread in 6000 sq.ft of area is acoustically engineered. Named after our revered President Abdul Kalam Azad, this multipurpose Hall provides stage facility to our students which helps them to become confident speakers who have no stage fear. The auditorium is well used for conferences, assemblies, visiting speakers, board examinations, debating, concerts and social events.

Dance Arena

A large mirrored dance arena allows children self-expression and enjoyment. A competent dance coach explains the intricacies of various dance forms and the kids are more than happy to spend hours in the Dance Arena.

Art & Craft Room

Painting, Drawing, Sketching, Paper craft and Clay modeling, Pottery, Sculpture and other forms of art which give a creative expression to abstract ideas also find equal priority with academics.

Computer Labs

The IT infrastructure setup of the Shivalik International School consists of well equipped computer labs. The school follows a graded computer education programme which enhances the computer knowledge & skills in all the classes up-to senior secondary.

Science Labs

The Science Labs are well equipped with required apparatus as specified by C.B.S.E. Students of even the primary wing are encouraged to visit the science labs for even the basic experiments so that they become interested and curious about science and enjoy doing a variety of experiments.

Social Study Lab

The school has a well-equipped social studies Laboratory. It is well equipped with equipment's, apparatuses and material required for the subject. It provides a work room for the student-teachers and a permanent display of important maps and globes, pictures and charts and constant reference to them makes the teaching of social studies effective, lively and interesting.

Math Lab

We all understand that math cannot be learnt. It has to be understood and practiced. The Math lab takes this concept a little further. Here students are made to experience the various principles and fundamentals of mathematics. Students get to understand the various concepts through the feel of real objects. To enhance the mathematical skills and the learning experience of the students, innovative and intriguing activities are carried out in the Math Lab.



Facilities

Infrastructure

Our school covers an area of 5 acres with lush green grounds in sylvan surroundings. The school building has been designed and built keeping in mind the children, the philosophy, and the future growth of the school. There is a planned space for every activity that takes place in the school.

Every aspect of the school infrastructure at The Shivalik International School is carefully conceived and created with a specific purpose in mind. Spaces are designed to influence learning. Large open spaces and innovatively planned infrastructure encourages learning beyond the classroom.

Classrooms equipped with smart boards and customized student friendly furniture facilitate holistic learning. The entire campus is Wi-Fi enabled, ensuring integration of technology into the teaching learning process at all levels.

Classrooms

The classrooms of The Shivalik International School are a pulsating space with excitement. Careful thought has been applied for the construction of the classrooms which are spacious, ventilated and allow plenty of natural light thus keeping the atmosphere fresh and making them ideal for concentrated learning. All Classrooms are equipped with smart boards having digital content to support teaching-learning. The content available consists of pedagogically sound and visually rich curriculum resources, mapped and customized as per the school's scheme of work. Also student lockers are provided so that students can bring lighter bags in accordance with the CBSE no-bag policy.



Indoor Badminton Court

The huge indoor badminton court is managed by talented coaches and we can proudly say that we have been consistently producing state and national level players. Many championships for various age groups are organized which keeps the badminton court buzzing.

Table Tennis Arena

An inviting table-tennis arena with four tables allows children to try their hand and learn the skill under the tutelage of experienced coaches.

Indoor Games

Students can enjoy Carom and Chess in the sports room in their recreational time.

Horse Riding Arena

The horse riding skills is taught to students under the supervision of a trained Riding Master. This is a seasonal activity, where in apposite weather conditions students of all age -groups learn and enjoy horse riding

Out-door Games

Extensive play areas are designated for Cricket, Football, Basketball, Golf, Physical Education, Sandpit and Splash pool

Infirmary

There is an infirmary in the school furnished with 2 beds, First aid medical kit & basic medicines required for curing general ailments from which young students suffer frequently. It is being taken care by a qualified para-medical & also has a doctor on call facility.

Dining Hall

Our Central Dining Hall provides the students and staff with the nutritious and well-balanced lunch and snacks in the afternoon and evening. In congruence with the policy of healthy eating, the school does not provide 'junk food' and aerated drinks.



➔ Mother-Teacher concept'

'Teachers hold their students' hand for a short while, but their hearts for ever.'

At The Shivalik International School , young Shivalians are nurtured under the tender care of mother teacher till Grade II. This concept helps in:-

- Understanding the child and developing an emotional bond between the learner and teacher.
- Helps in better insight to various developmental stages of the child, especially cognitive and emotional.
- Both the learner and teacher spend more time with each other and the teacher personally knows the areas of concern.
- Academically it gives time for the child to remain abreast with his peers.
- It gives a sense of satisfaction to the teacher, at the end of the session, on accomplishing the set targets as per the potential of the child and helping in the positive growth graph of each student.

➔ Pre-Nursery

In the Pre-Nursery class the child learns to discover, explore and experiment in a stimulating and conducive environment. The activities aim at developing tiny-tots independence and confidence. The curriculum is planned around development of fine motor skills, gross motor skills and cognitive development. Fine Motor Skills and Gross Motor skills are imparted through specially designed exercises.

Teaching - Learning Strategies are activity -based. They include creative Art & Craft activities , use of puppetry , songs and rhymes , games , swings , field-trips and performing arts such as dancing , singing and role-plays.



KS-I & II

In these early years classes, emphasis is on nurturing the child's imagination, creativity and providing him opportunities to express himself freely. We lay stress upon developing basic language skills with the help of phonetics and conversation. A sound knowledge of phonetics helps the child to build spellings independently. Various celebrations in the school and round-the-year activities allow self-expression, experimentation and questioning; thereby developing a scientific temper. There is a perfect balance of active and quiet activities, structured, besides the free-play activities.

Classes I TO V

"If I cannot learn the way you teach me,

At the primary level, it is our constant endeavor to facilitate and provide a productive learning process through activity-oriented lessons, stimulating hands-on work and extensive co-curricular activities. Learning goes beyond books through projects, multimedia presentations, group work and collaborative learning, circle time and worksheets specially designed to encourage lateral thinking.

A child's mind is like wet clay and needs to be handled with care. Keeping this in mind, we The Shivalik International School provide an encouraging and loving atmosphere, fused with a lot of fun, so that students shed their inhibitions and learn with a free mind.

Grades VI TO VIII

Middle school is the stage of transition for the students from an activity based learning environment in the primary section, to the stage where teaching methodology is completely focused on the pursuit of knowledge and development of understanding and skills necessary to interpret experience.

Our middle school curriculum provides and promotes a learning environment based upon developmental readiness, needs and interests. The curriculum is broad based with emphasis on the core subjects. Students are engaged in experiential learning through a variety of resources in order to develop the appropriate knowledge and skill levels.

We follow the CBSE (CCE) pattern at middle school level. We ensure such Formative Assessment tasks are given which involve collaboration, discussion and reflection. Speaking and learning skills, presentation skills and practical skills and all the co-scholastic areas are assessed formatively.

Grades IX & X

All the teachers at TSIS aim primarily to help the learner with systematic learning and development. Teachers use various types of modern teaching aids to connect with students, along with interactive and creative class room teaching. Our classes are equipped with modern teaching aids such as Interactive White boards and educational software.

The major emphasis of CCE at the class IX, X level is on continuous growth of students, ensuring their intellectual, emotional, physical, cultural and social development.

The CCE pattern has been ingrained effectively with justified and equal importance being given to scholastic and non-scholastic areas in academics.

Formative Assessments carry 40% weightage, while Summative Assessments are graded for 60% in the entire academic year.

The students are exposed to various interesting Formative Assessments like Role Plays, Brochure making, Magazine designing, Powerpoint presentation, Surveys, Model making, Quiz etc.

The Shivalik International School firmly believes that every child is entitled to childhood. While education is the primary function of a school, education at The Shivalik International School includes all activities that go into personality building.

On the basis of age, each child is encouraged to indulge in sports and cultural activities of his interest, and class room education does not infringe into a child's right to play, sing, dance and be himself.
